

JEREMIAH JEOPARDY REVIEW GAME

Group members might enjoy playing a round of Jeremiah Jeopardy as a way of review. You might plan in advance to extend your last session by 10-15 minutes, if possible. Or, if you plan to have a separate celebration session, you could play the game then.

Draw the category playing board on a whiteboard or posterboard. Divide the room in half and flip a coin to decide which team goes first. (You might ask your apprentice leader to keep score.) The first team chooses a category and point value. (For example, "We'll take Listening for 400.") When they choose a value, cross it off as an option (either erase from whiteboard or put an X on the posterboard chart) so that on future turns participants will know it is no longer an option.

When the team chooses a category and point value, read the corresponding "answer" from the answer chart, reminding them to frame their response in the form of a question. Don't be a stickler about exact answers; if they get in the ballpark, give it to them. If they answer incorrectly, the other team gets an opportunity to steal the points by answering. If neither team answers correctly, give the answer and cross off the question. The answers worth 500 are more difficult than the 100 values.
